

NEESPI Science Advisory Panel (SAP) committee near-real-term plans (in brief)

Point 1. Regional assessment needs to be performed.

This will be a compilation and integration of the existing knowledge plus, these will include reports from the on-going projects.

Point 2. NEESPI “intermediate” Implementation Plan that has objectives helping Managers to formulate their cause and helping managers and scientists to write proposals for the next 3 years should be developed.

The Plan draft should be presented at the next NEESPI SAP Meeting. If there is no funding, it'll be valuable anyway. Further, It is important to state exciting goals to generate new funding.

Point 3. Thereafter, we 'll see how NEESPI will contribute to GEOSS

Point 4. Strong commitment to educational activities.

Continue running, proposing, and organizing of Summer Schools for young scientists. IPY activities might be of a great help.
